Pat Lorie – The city is planning to develop denser housing. We are being considered for a Local Area Plan. Montgomery Place will get new street lights. Residents are expressing concerns, particularly about overhead wires running from east to west. Eleventh St. will be closed again at Ave. H to facilitate expansion of the water reservoir. Demolition of the old Intercon building will begin soon. The tenders should be let for the Circle Drive Bridge soon.

Danielle Chartier – Danielle’s office should be open on 11<sup>th</sup> St. fairly soon.

President – Juanita Kitzul – There’s a rink coordinator workshop coming up.

Vice President – Jim Earle – A truck hit the information sign on McNaughton Ave. and damaged it. Jim will try to get it fixed.

Rink – Jim Earle – The snow blower isn’t starting. It’s getting difficult to get parts for it. A hose is cracking too and will need to be replaced in the near future.

There is a seasonal phone hook up at the rink shack. It is not working and the person working there has a cell phone.
