City of Saskatoon
Waste & Recycling Plan
While we don't often think of where our garbage goes, solid waste management – collecting garbage, providing recycling and yard waste composting facilities and managing the Saskatoon landfill – is one of the largest and most costly services provided by the City of Saskatoon.

Why do we need a plan?
As the city grows, we need to plan for the future of managing our waste. We need to use new ideas to help us reduce the amount of waste we produce, and recycle more of it as well. Doing these things will help us: Make the existing landfill last as long as possible. Continue to manage waste in an effective and efficient way. Protect our environment today and for future generations. What's been done so far? Over the past year, three

advisory groups have been working with the City to examine future challenges and identify possible options for improving waste management: The Public Advisory group, made up of 12 volunteer members of the public selected through a city-wide recruitment process, offers valuable feedback on the suitability or acceptability of various options. The Technical Advisory Group of key waste management and recycling partners and private sector stewardship agencies helps proposed options are technically sound. The Local Government Group, which includes City administration, two Councillors and a representative from the RM of Corman Park helps oversee the process, ensures various viewpoints are taken into account, and forwards information to Council for considerations. The three Advisory Groups and the City have worked with consultants Earth Tech (Canada) Inc. to examine future

future challenges and identify possible options for dealing with our waste. The proposed Draft Plan is now ready for review. Circle Drive Study is out in
public domain. Does not look
good for Montgomery Place.
There is a "future" connection
between Valley Road and High-
way 7, but in the meantime, how
do they plan to get the traffic
from Highway 7 to the bridge
without going down 11th St??
The cost of the project is up to
250 million, so they plan on
"staging" the roadway. The only
place they can really save any
money is to have the intersec-
tion at 11th St & Circle at grade,
and the intersection of the CP &
CN lines at grade as well.

They say that this will save
them 50 million. At 27,000
vehicles per day it won't take
much of a train to block the
track and send the lineup of cars
back to the river. (Not only that,
I think they will run the road
down Dundonald and leave
everything as it is at 11th &
Dundonald until they can afford
to build the interchanges. Let's
see, it's taken us 40 years to get
to this point. This plan is the
worst case scenario for
Montgomery Place. We end up
with traffic on 11th & traffic on
Dundonald. Thanks a lot. We
spend 7 or 8 years working on
this, and it's as if we weren't
even there).
