REMEMBERING MONTGOMERY VETERANS

The first group of World War II veterans, fifteen in total, moved to Montgomery Place in 1946 and three more veteran families in 1947. This was the start of our great community. More homes were built between 1954 and 1977 when the Veterans Land Act was closed off.

In early 1989, several Veteran residents formed a committee and erected a memorial cairn to recognize the reasons for and the establishment of our community. The cairn was place in the northwest corner of Montgomery Park. Every year on November 11th we remember these veterans as we hold a remembrance day service at this cairn.

Montgomery Place has seen many changes over the years and still retains a diverse and vibrant mix of families who have made this community their own.

We should all thank these Canadian Armed Forces veterans who not only served our country during times of war, but who created such a lasting and great community.
