Treasurer

Length of Term: 2 years.

Job Description: Responsible for the coordination of all financial matters relating to the Community Association.

Responsibilities:

1) Maintain the financial records of the Community Association in accordance with the recognized accounting procedures.

2) Ensures that all Directors and Coordinators have submitted yearly budgets as required.

3) Prepares an up-to-date financial statement for presentation at each monthly Executive meeting of the Community Association.

4) Acts as co-signatory on documents and cheques drawn on Association funds as required in the conduct of Association business.

5) Assists in preparation of grant applications.

6) Responsible for the collection of all monies, (registration, membership fees, misc.) due to the Association.

7) Responsible for the deposit of all incoming monies and payment of all expenses incurred by the Association at the designated financial institution.

8) Coordinates the preparation of an annual budget for all activities of the Association.

9) Arranges for auditing of the financial records at the close of each fiscal year, and presents an audited financial statement to the Annual General Meeting of the Association.

Secretary

Length of Term: 2 years.

Job Description: To act as overall recorder of the proceedings of the Community Association.

Responsibilities:

1) Records and preserves a record of all proceedings of all the Board meetings, i.e. annual, general, or special meetings.

2) Records the attendance of Directors at Board meetings.

3) Types the minutes and distributes them to the Board of Directors and Community Consultant personnel as soon as possible after the meeting.

4) Assists in the preparation and distribution of the agenda prior to the next meeting.

5) Makes notification of the next meeting to all Directors by phone, written announcements, or minutes of

previous meetings.

6) Handles all correspondence as directed by the Board of Directors.

7) Keeps a record of all committees and committee members.

8) Handles the typing and mailing of all correspondence.

9) Distributes minutes of previous meetings.

10) Maintains a file of all correspondence, minutes, agendas, committees, Board members, and a history of all motions.

Director of Education

Length of Term: 2 years.

Job Description: Liaison between the Community Association and the Parent Councils in the community.
