Snow Routes

Recently Snow Route signs have appeared in Montgomery Place. Here is some information provided by City of Saskatoon. To maximize resources and reduce the inconvenience to traffic flow, snow plows and salt and sand spreaders operate according to a designated network of streets called the Priority System. The first priority is the movement of traffic on streets with high traffic counts followed closely by access to fire halls, ambulance sites and hospitals, and bus routes. Other priorities include the remainder of arterials and collectors, and streets adjacent to schools not already assigned a priority. While every effort is made to clear streets as soon as possible, continuing snow

means that road maintenance crews work on Priority One and Two streets until they are clear before they start to work on Priority Three streets. If snow accumulates on the high traffic streets, a Snow Route Temporary Parking Ban may be declared. Residential streets are not included in the Priority System, and will only be cleared under extraordinary circumstances. Grading to reduce ruts will be carried out when required and as resources permit. Residential snow removal will only be completed in particular cases to improve spring run-off conditions, or in areas with a high concentration of parked vehicles such as the University or Kelsey campus. If major snow clearing is required in residential areas in exceptional circumstances, temporary "No Parking" signs will inform motorists that they have up to 18 hours to removed parked vehicles from designated streets. Vehicles not moved as required will be ticketed and either towed to a street nearby or impounded, depending on the circumstances.

Priority 2

Includes: Access to emergency locations (fire halls, ambulance sites and hospitals) and bus routes.

Timing for Snow Clearing: Within 36 hours after snowfall ends.

Timing for Sanding: Within 12 hours of the development of icy conditions.

Objective: To ensure that key emergency transportation routes are passable, and to enable the safe and normal movement of public transportation.

Priority 3

Includes: Remainder arterials and collectors, and streets adjacent to schools not already assigned a priority.

Timing for Snow Clearing: Within 72 hours after snowfall ends.

Timing for Sanding: Within 24 hours of the development of icy conditions.

Objective: To ensure that children are able to get to school in all weather conditions.

Snow accumulation on the high traffic Snow Route streets can be cleared

more quickly and efficiently when parked vehicles are removed. After a significant amount of snow (in excess of 7 centimetres) and/or winds that cause drifting on high traffic streets, a Snow Route Temporary Parking Ban may be declared. By declaring the Snow Route and enforcing the Temporary Parking Ban, the City hopes to improve safety and mobility for all of us through the winter months. Motorists are responsible for knowing when a Snow Route Temporary Parking Ban is in effect, and should consider this before parking on the Snow Route. Snow Route continued

Register to Receive Snow Route e-Notifications You can register to receive an e-Notification every time a Snow Route Temporary Parking Ban is declared, and when it is lifted. If you have more than one email address or to receive e-Notification at home and at the office, you can register twice. When you register for the Snow Route e-Notification service, you will only receive information relating to Snow Route Temporary Parking Bans. The service is free and you may unsubscribe at any time. To register, email snow.route@saskatoon.ca and enter your first and last name in the body of the email. After you have submitted your registration, you will receive an email asking you to confirm your request for the e-Notification. If you do not confirm your request, you will not be added to the Snow Route Temporary Parking Ban e-Notification database, and you will not receive any e-Notifications.
