Description of the positions:

President

Length of Term: 1 year.

Job Description: The President is the overall leader of the Community Association who coordinates the activities of the executive/board and ensures that the Community Association carries out its functions according to its guidelines, (constitution/bylaws), and objectives.

Responsibilities:

1) Acts as chairman for all meetings of the Board of Directors and all annual meetings and/or general meetings of the Community Association.

2) Assists the Secretary in the preparation of the agenda for each meeting and ensures that all members receive a copy of the agenda prior to each meeting.

3) Chairs all meetings according to parliamentary procedure, i.e. Roberts Rule of Order.

4) Votes only in cases of a tie.

5) Is an ex-officio member of all standing committees and designates jobs to committees.

6) Ensures that correspondence is presented to the Board of Directors.

7) Has signing authority for payments made by the Community Association and all legal papers or contracts.

8) Ensures that all Directors are given training in their duties and functions on the Board of Directors.

9) Assumes overall responsibility for coordination of various Community Association activities.

10) Acts on the Community Association's behalf in matters pertaining to the Association to various levels of government, outside agencies, the City of Saskatoon, and at public functions.

11) Assists in the preparation of grant applications.

Vice-President

Length of Term: 1 year.

Job Description: Assists the President in the overall leadership and operation of the Community Association.

Responsibilities:

1) In the absence of the President, acts on his/her behalf and has all authorities and responsibilities generally designated to the President.

2) Coordinates special committees when required.

3) Acts as a President-in-training, learning all aspects of the organization.

4) Has signing authority for payments made by the Association, and for all legal papers and contracts pertaining to the Association.

The following position is very important for the Winter registration. We need this position filled, maybe two or three people could be involved together.

Director of Indoor Programs

Length of Term: 2 years.

Job Description: Coordinates all recreation programs sponsored by the Community Association, and conducted in schools and other neighbourhood facilities in cooperation with the Leisure Services Department.

Responsibilities:

1) Presents a list of indoor recreation activities for the fall and winter sessions for approval by the Board of Directors.

2) Sets the fees for the activities with the Board of Directors approval.

3) Sets up a schedule for the use of the schools for activities the Association decides to run.

4) Ensures that instructors are confirmed for all programs and applies to the Board of Education for use of the school facilities according to their guidelines.

5) Understands and interprets the rules and regulations involving the use of the schools.

6) Under timelines, presents a list of all indoor recreation activities to the City's Community Consultant to ensure that program activities, descriptions, locations, dates, times, and fees are included in the Leisure Activity Guide and the community newsletter.

7) Sets up and coordinates the registration for the fall and winter programs.

8) Draws up contracts for those instructors paid by the Community Association.

9) Submits a list of expenses for the Board of Director's approval, i.e. instructor's supplies.

10) Submits an annual budget for all indoor programs to the Board of Directors for approval.
