Montgomery Place has benefitted from the construction of a number of new homes in the past few years. In most cases infill housing has improved our area. This may not be the case in every situation. We are often concerned when we see a new structure going up because it will have an effect on our community and we have very little control over what may be being built there.

In the past when lots were being rapidly subdivided the community association worked with the cities' administrators to develop a minimum size for lots so that the nature of our community would not be changed.

At the present time our area is zoned R2. This means that duplexes and other types of multiple family dwell-

ings can be constructed on almost any lot in the neighborhood. We would like to see the zoning changed, partly to protect the value of homes in our area and partly to protect the nature of the community.

If the zoning was changed to R1, some of our homes could not be rebuilt after a catastrophic event such as a fire because they are not set back far enough from the street. We are considering asking the city to change the zoning of all the lots in Montgomery Place from R2 to R1A. This would allow us to keep our present set backs from city land and would allow the development of a basement suite if a resident wished to have one. Existing duplexes would be grandfathered but no new duplexes would be allowed.

Changing the zoning would require a process of consultation with area residents. We would need to show that there was a community consensus in support of the change. In order to do this we would probably need to circulate a petition and have a public meeting before approaching city hall about the change.

Please feel free to contact the members of our association to let us know what you think about this. It may be a change that will benefit our community for many years.
